

Assemblée annuelle 2015 - Centre des Naudières - Nantes

How to get to the Centre des Naudières from the main railway station

The number 1 tramway line passes in front of the central SNCF railway station; the stop is right in front of the entrance. You must buy a ticket from the automatic ticket machine on the platform. It costs 1.50 € and is valid for 1 hour starting from the time you punch the ticket inside the tram car. Take a number 1 tram in the direction of “Frederic Mitterand”.

The Centre des Naudières is located in the residential area called Rezé, which is serviced by the **C4 bus**. (On the network map that you will have received the C4 is the green perpendicular line south of the river.) Once on the tram, you have two options for connecting with the C4:

- Get off at the next stop, '**Duchesse Anne Château**' then take **bus number 4** in the direction of Porte de Vertou. (The bus stop is right next to the tram stop.) Get off at **Greneraie**, which is the starting point for the C4 going in the direction of Les Sorinières.
- Or get off the tram further on at the '**Commerce**' stop, a major crossroads in the centre. From there, cross over to the tramlines bisecting Line 1 and take either **Line 2** (direction Pont Rousseau) or **Line 3** (direction Neustrie). Get off at **Pirmil**, cross the tracks to the other platform and take a **C4 bus** (direction Les Sorinières).

Get off the bus at either **Trois Moulins** or the next stop, **Lechat**. In either case, cross the street and walk less than a minute to turn left on Rue des Naudières our Rue Lechat. (If you have a rolling suitcase, Rue Lechat is easier to manage.) Walk 5 minutes to the entrance of the Centre des Naudières.

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You can buy a ticket on a bus but it costs 2 €. Think about buying an extra ticket or two when you arrive for the outing on Saturday, which will begin with a bus.
